The payout was based on the level of achievement of financial targets for the performance period ended September 30, 2016. The restricted stock units were subject to a one-year vesting period. The payout of the other 60% was previously reported. Of the 58,480 earned units, the reporting person previously transfered the economic interests of 29,240 units to his ex-wife pursuant to a domestic relations order. Mr. Monser disclaims beneficial ownership of such units and does not report them as beneficially owned.
- 2. Price is not applicable to the acquisition or vesting of the restricted stock units described in Note 1 or to the acquisition of Issuer common stock upon such vesting.
- 3. Shares withheld for required minimum taxes upon vesting of restricted stock units described in Note 1 exempt pursuant to Rule 16b-3.
